



### **Connect Study 18: Huldah- Trusted**

*'She [Huldah] said to them, "This is what the Lord, the God of Israel, says: Tell the man who sent you to me, 'This is what the Lord says'..."*  
(2 Chronicles 34:23f, NIV)

Huldah was an ordinary woman, the wife of Hasrah, the keeper of the wardrobe, but she was trusted and known for her wisdom and willingness to listen to the word of God. Her willingness and readiness opened a door of influence for her. Trustworthy messengers bring trustworthy messages.

Consider the following questions in relation to your own life:

- **She spoke in her season**

- Read 1 Timothy 1:12-14 and 2 Timothy 2:15**

- How willing are you to be used as God's messenger? What keeps you from speaking the word of God to others? Discuss how you can find opportunities in the busyness of your season to encourage others.

- **She spoke to the man**

- Read 2 Chronicles 34:22-23**

- Huldah was not intimidated even by speaking to the king. Who intimidates you?

- Read 2 Corinthians 3:4-5**

- Where did Paul find his confidence to speak out? What do you need to do to overcome your insecurities about speaking even to those who you find intimidating?

- **She spoke what God spoke**

- Read 2 Chronicles 34:24-33**

- What was the message that Huldah brought and what was the king's response? Note: Huldah's responsibility was to deliver the message faithfully. She was not responsible for Josiah's response. Discuss how knowing that the response to the message is not up



to you help you when you believe God has given you something to say.

**Read John 12:49 and 5:19-20**

How was Jesus faithful to the message he was given? What can distract you from hearing from God?

**Action:** When someone shares a need, use the opportunity to pray with them.

**Prayer:** Pray for opportunities to speak God's word into other people's lives and that, as you step out, your confidence in Him would grow.
