Recap

- As Christians, we believe that scripture teaches, “For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God” (Romans 3:23). It’s true: we have missed the mark and come under His judgment. But because of the work of Christ, we have access to God’s grace and goodness. If we just turn from our imperfect attitudes, speech, and behaviours, God can take our sin and turned it into power!
- As Ps. Brian explains, repentance isn’t only about remedying our separation from God, but also about becoming more like Jesus. Why would we limit ourselves, and focus only on how sinful we are, when we can move forward and learn to live more like Jesus? Jesus gave Himself as an example for us to follow. The more we follow Him, the more we want to experience His goodness and glory and the less we focus on the very sin from which we’ve been set free.

 - Going forward, what are some ways you can utilize the power of sin to grow your relationship with Christ?
